ENP Priorities - 2015 Review

Goal: increase stabilisation and resilience of the region

Key priority areas:

- ✓ Good governance, democracy, rule of law and human rights
- ✓ **Economic and social development**: market access, modernisation for growth, entrepreneurship, focus on jobs and skills, fostering in particular youth **employability** and SMEs development
- ✓ Transport interconnections; Energy and Climate action
- ✓ Security cooperation on conflict resolution, crisis prevention, new threats and civil protection
- ✓ Mutually-beneficial migration and mobility

Main principle = differentiation

Riga Priorities - EaP

- Strengthening of institutions and good governance
- Market opportunities (improved business environment, SME support, efficient transit of goods)
- Interconnections (energy security, transportation and supply; transport links safer and more efficient)
- Mobility and people-to-people contacts (key role of cooperation in education, youth, culture, research and innovation)



Role of education

- Foundation upon which to build capacity in all sectors
- Provides basic and transversal skills needed in all jobs and for flexible labour market
- Contributes to mutual understanding, dialogue and openness
- Advanced and professional qualifications provided in higher education respond to identified needs

- Member of the Bologna Process since 2015 only
- Ambitious Roadmap of Reforms
 - Structured reforms
 - ✓ Develop an NQF compatible with the QF-EHEA
 - ✓ Introduce the 3-cycle system
 - ✓ Implement ECTS
 - ✓ Develop a plan for issuing Diploma Supplement
 - Commit to establishing independent quality assurance
 - Further work on recognition
 - Facilitate and develop mobility and internationalisation
 - Commitment to fundamental values of EHEA
- ❖ BFUG AG2 report expected in 2018

Priorities in Erasmus+ CBHE

- Modernisation of curriculum by developing new and innovative courses and methodologies: curriculum development, modernise teaching, revise content, etc.
- Modernisation of governance, management and functioning of higher education: decision-making processes, strategies, rigorous quality assurance measures, support services, internationalisation, developing research capacity, access to HE from vulnerable groups, etc.
- ❖ Developing the Higher Education sector within society at large: LLL, HE VET, university-business cooperation, NQF, knowledge triangle, regional cooperation in HE, reform policy development, implementation and monitoring, etc.
